**Excess Entries**

In the event of more entries being received than can be accommodated, alpaca entries may be reduced. If necessary the number of alpacas from any one exhibitor may also be reduced to a figure determined by the Show Convenor. The exhibitor will have the right to nominate the alpacas to be withdrawn, should this reduction be necessary.

**General**

This Show will be conducted as an Age Championship Show under the rules of the Australian Alpaca Association Ltd., (the Association), as set out in the current Showing Rules Manual.

**Period of Exhibition:**

Alpacas must be penned by 8.30 am Saturday 2nd March 2024 and may not be removed from the showgrounds until all judging is completed. Penning the day before the show may be available, however, overnight security will not be provided. Please contact the convenor to arrange this if necessary

**Exhibit Numbers**

Exhibitors shall, on the day of the Show, obtain their exhibit numbers from the Registration Desk in the Alpaca pavilion. Exhibit numbers are not to be displayed on the animals but must be worn by the handler whilst in the show ring. It is recommended that exhibit numbers be displayed in armbands (worn on the left arm). Please ensure you bring your arm bands with you, as we will not have any available for purchase on the day.
