REGULATIONS:

A valid vendor declaration must be given to the stewards before unloading exhibits.

- a. Exhibits must be **penned by 9.00 am** Friday and may be removed at 5 pm.
- b. All sheep in shorn classes to have been closely and evenly shorn, not more than 2 cm of staple length.
- c. All sheep must be bona fide property of the exhibitor one month before the show.
- d. All sheep must be registered with their respective breed societies.
- e. Awarding of Ribbons: 1 to 5 entries 2 ribbons; 6 to 8 entries 3 ribbons; 9 entries up 4 ribbons.
- f. All lambs show milk teeth only.
- g. All South Suffolk Sheep to be presented for showing must be machine-shorn annually between 1st September and 31st October and may be re-shorn at any time thereafter during the year.
- h. Ram entries will only be accepted from accredited Brucellosis Free Flocks. At the request of Breed Societies, Certificates must be handed in on arrival, before sheep are unloaded, otherwise sheep will not be permitted in pavilion.
- i. Points for most successful exhibitor: 1st 2, 2nd 1, Champion 1.
- j. Novice breeder is one who has not won a first prize at a major show.
- k. To receive the most successful exhibitor trophy, there must be more than one exhibitor in the given breed.
- I. Entry & Declaration Forms **MUST BE COMPLETED** when entering.
- m. Pairs to be penned separately.
