#### **REGULATIONS:**

a. All entries are to be entered by 5 pm Wednesday 28th February 2024 at the Show Office.

NB Fleeces entered in Class 3419 must be delivered to Nutrien Ag by Friday 16th February 2024 for testing

- b. All wool is to be at the Pavilion before 9.00 am, Friday 1st March or leave entries at Nutrien Ag, Boorowa.
- c. All fleeces are judged on a points system. Point Score: 3 for First, 2 for Second, 1 for Champion.
- d. Fleeces must not show growth exceeding 12 months and must be owned by the exhibitor for more than 12 months.
- e. All fleeces exhibited to be skirted. Skirtings and bellies are not required with any entries.
- f. **No brands** are to be present in any Fleece Wool.
- g. Ram fleeces are only allowed in classes 3406-34099 or 3415-3418.
- h. One entry per woolpack or bag. **Do not** place two entries in one pack or bag.
- j. Wool packs or bags with entries to be in good condition and marked with the entrant's name.
- k. Wool will be ready for collection at 4.00 pm on Show Day (Saturday).
- m. Wool is to be collected no later than Sunday lunchtime the day after the Show. Any wool left in the pavilion, without prior collection arrangements made with the Chief Wool Steward, will be considered a donation to the Boorowa Show Society.
